



# Wine

Grapes are the most globally common fruit used as the base raw material for alcoholic fermentation.

Historically, wine is the product of several different grape varieties, picked for their natural composition of sugars and yeast, which are the elements required for fermentation.

The first ever recorded consumption of wine dated back to 4500bc. Currently the most renowned wine producing regions are Spain, Italy, California, France and South Africa.

<b>JAPAN</b>	<b>NIKKA COFFEY</b> Sweet, fruity flavours of melon, grapefruit, and thick syrup, balanced by crunchy biscuits and fresh vanilla, then corn notes, sweet and vibrant, last on the finish.	<b>22</b>
<b>GERMANY</b>	<b>MONKEY 47</b> Predictably complex, robust and powerful gin with plenty of spice, fruit and herb flavours, very well structured, and difficult to unpick but a citrus fresh start segues into pine and wood notes for a drying finish.	<b>22</b>

<b>POLAND</b>	<b>BELVEDERE</b> Notes of vanilla and rye on the palate, the finish is crisp and clean with lingering white pepper spice, a distinctive creamy mouth feel, aromas of a blend of vanilla, rye and white pepper.	<b>8</b>
<b>RUSSIA</b>	<b>BELUGA NOBLE</b> Produced from 100% wheat grain, subtly flavoured with sugar, honey, oatmeal infusion, holy thistle and vanilla, with hints of spice develop.	<b>8</b>
<b>JAPAN</b>	<b>NIKKA COFFEY</b> Soft and rounded with hints of citrus: fresh lemon zest and grapefruit peel with sweet and creamy notes hide underneath.	<b>22</b>

<b>THAILAND</b>	<b>CHALONG BAY</b> Chocolate and coffee aroma, moving quickly to spicier notes of pepper, nutmeg, and chili, a very pure and satisfying lychee note develops.	18
